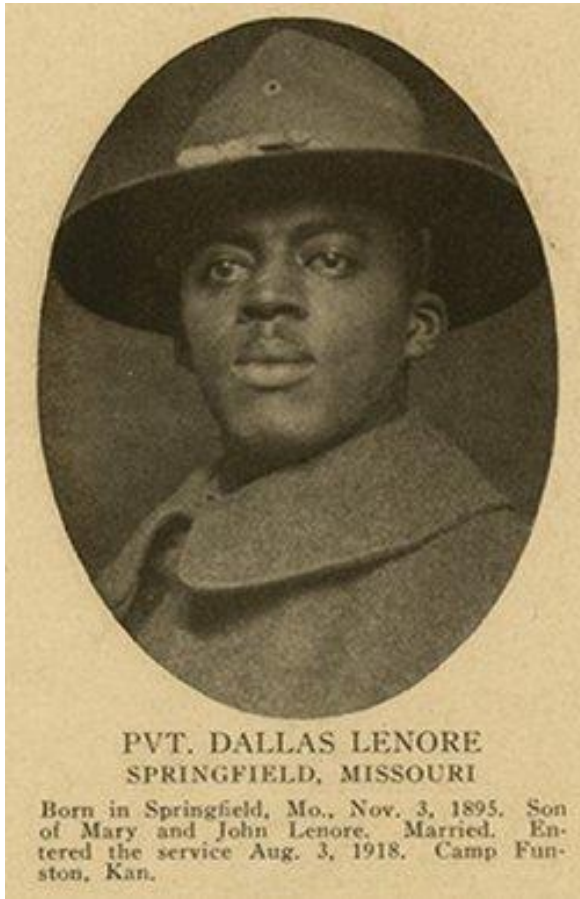


# Dallas Lenore

Dallas Lenore was born 3 November 1891 and passed away 16 January 1961. He is interred at the Fort Leavenworth National Cemetery. He was a Private in Co. 10, 7th Regiment, 164 Depot Brigade during WWI. He registered with the draft while living in Springfield MO and was discharged from the US Army 20 November 1918.
