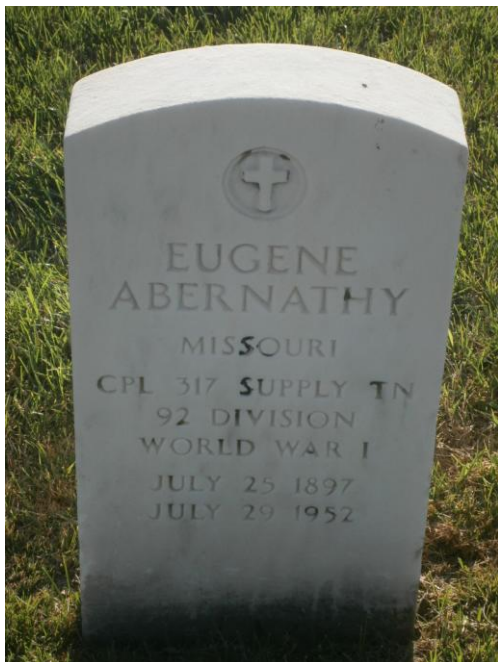




**CORP. EUGENE ABERNATHY**
